



## **IFA InteatroFestival Academy 2009**

### **IV International Call for Proposals**

IFA InteatroFestival Academy is the name of the professional artistic project promoted and founded in 2006 by Inteatro. Every year, young artists of various nationalities have the possibility to stay for a long period in Villa Nappi, in order to work with established artists.

#### RECIPIENTS

The program has 12 vacancies for young artists / performers aged between 18 and 32 years, of different nationalities, who want to gain experience in research and training for the development of their practice.

#### COURSE STRUCTURE

IFA 2009 will start on Monday May 18<sup>th</sup> and will end on July 4<sup>th</sup> 2009.

During their weeks in residency, the participants will explore their working methods and theatrical languages, with international artistic directors and performers, who will guide them in their personal and artistic growth.

Among the Mentors who have already confirmed their participation: **Rosa Casado** (Madrid), **Cláudia Dias** (Lisbon), **Gustavo Frigerio** (Rome), **Jan Ritsema** (St Erme Outre et Ramecourt), **Aydin Teker** (Istanbul).

The participants will have the possibility to develop their personal projects within the planned working sessions. The course is intensive, and attendance is mandatory.

The working sessions will take place in the morning, afternoons or evenings as decided by the mentors and for a maximum of 8 hours per day in the spaces of Villa Nappi and Teatro della Luna in Polverigi. Days off will also be agreed with the Mentors.

## PARTICIPATION TERMS

Participants may be awarded a scholarship<sup>1</sup> to cover the costs of the attendance to the workshops, lodging, work and study spaces at Villa Nappi and Teatro della Luna.

Participants are responsible for their living costs and personal insurance.

## APPLICATIONS

To participate in the program, applicants must send:

- letter of application
- curriculum vitae, including personal details (name, surname, address, telephone, email)
- a research project proposal that the candidate would like to develop during the residency.

It is possible to add video materials, texts, and photos of previous works that may be useful in understanding the candidate's training and creative experience.

Application can be submitted in Italian, English or French.

The received applications will not be returned.

## SELECTIONS

An international artistic committee will make a first selection.

Results will be communicated, in any case, by April 20<sup>th</sup>, 2009.

Selected applicants will then be invited to audition. Auditions should be in the form of a performed live work (max 10 minutes) and will take place in Polverigi in Inteatro's headquarters

<sup>1</sup> To qualify for the scholarship, it is necessary to assure attendance to the course for at least 80% of its duration. For lodging at Villa Nappi a deposit will be demanded, which will be repaid at the end of the course.
